The Sea Level Rise Task Force, created in 2007 by the New York State Legislature to apply the best available science to the impacts from rising seas, has brought together NYS agencies including departments of State, Environmental Conservation, Transportation; State Emergency Management Organization, county and local governments from New York City, Westchester, Suffolk and Nassau counties, non-profits such as The Nature Conservancy and specific appointments including Jerry Mulligan, Westchester County Commissioner of Planning. The task force's final report is due to the Legislature by January 1, 2011, and a draft, including recommendations, is expected to be released in early June 2010.
